3 - MONTH PERIODONTAL RECARE VISIT

Scaling and Root Planing is a non-surgical approach to control periodontal disease. There is <u>NO CURE</u> for periodontal disease; it can only be managed or controlled.

The bacteria that can cause periodontal disease will re-establish in 3 months after treatment. A <u>3-MONTH RECARE</u> visit is critically timed to disrupt these bacteria in pockets greater than three millimeters (3mm) in order to disable the destructive process at its critical stage. This critical stage is when bacteria and microorganisms do the most harm to the supporting structures, namely the *periodontal attachment*.

For patients with adult periodontitis (<u>periodontal disease</u>), supportive 3-month recare is not an option, rather is a requirement for successful therapy. *
